

Kendall County Special Education Cooperative HOME/HOSPITAL INSTRUCTION PROGRAM

Purpose

The purpose Home/Hospital Instruction is to provide students who are unable to attend school due to temporary medical conditions the option to receive instruction in a hospital or home setting. The focus of the instruction is to keep the student current with academic work and facilitate a smooth re-entry into the school setting.

Program Goals

- The provision of instruction by appropriately certified teachers to keep students academically current while out of school for medical reasons.
- To coordinate Home/Hospital instruction with the student's current academic curriculum.
- To provide ongoing implementation of Individualized Education Programs to special education students during absences due to medical reasons as determined by the IEP team.

Entrance Criteria

- Parental request for Home/Hospital services.
- Documentation from a doctor that the student will be out of school for more than ten consecutive days and will require Home/Hospital instruction.
- Special education students require an IEP review prescribing and documenting the Home/Hospital services.

Exit Criteria

- Students will exit Home/Hospital services upon medical clearance stating that the student can return to the school setting.

Available Home/Hospital Services

- Home/Hospital Services. These services are provided in the home or hospital setting to students who are out of school for more than ten consecutive days due to a medical condition. The services are facilitated by the student's home school and provided by appropriately certified personnel.

Related services are provided to Home/Hospital program students according to their IEP.
